

**EMPLOYMENT DATA FOR THE UNDERGRADUATE CLASS OF 2015
UPDATED 12/5/2016**

Methodology: Student response to survey sent out by GCU Career Services office. Students are listed only once. Those who marked attending graduate school were counted in only that category regardless of any other category they marked. After those attending graduate school were accounted for, the remaining respondents were placed into one of the three employment categories: full-time, part-time or unemployed. Unemployed includes those who are not seeking employment as well as those who are seeking employment.

6 Months After Graduation

With 69.5% of the undergraduate class reporting:

67.6% report that they are employed
42.6% Full-time
25.0% Part-time
17% attending graduate school
15.4% report that they are unemployed

Here's how it breaks down by school

A&S – 68% reporting

62.2% report that they are employed
31.8% Full-time
30.4% Part-time
20% are attending graduate school
17.8% report that they are unemployed

Business – 67.6% reporting

78.2% report that they are employed
65.2% Full-time
13% Part-time
21.8% are attending graduate school
0% report that they are unemployed

Education– 69.8% reporting

75% report that they are employed
48% Full-time
27% Part-time
9% are attending graduate school
16% report that they are unemployed

Nursing– 80% reporting

88% report that they are employed
72% Full-time
16% Part-time
0% are attending graduate school
12% report that they are unemployed

9 Months After Graduation

With 74.5% of the undergraduate class reporting

73% report that they are employed
49% Full-time
24% Part-time
17% attending graduate school
10% report that they are unemployed

Here's how it breaks down by school

A&S – 70% reporting

63.4% report that they are employed
33.9% Full-time
29.6% Part-time
22% are attending graduate school
14.5% report that they are unemployed

Business – 65% reporting

82.7% report that they are employed
73% Full-time
9.7% Part-time
19.3% are attending graduate school
0% report that they are unemployed

Education– 69.3% reporting

74.4% report that they are employed
48.8% Full-time
25.6% Part-time
9.3% are attending graduate school
13.9% report that they are unemployed

Nursing– 90% reporting

93.1% report that they are employed
82.4% Full-time
10.6% Part-time
0% are attending graduate school
7% report that they are unemployed
