End of Course Reflection

Fall 2016

At the conclusion of the fall semester, Georgian Court University (GCU) faculty completed an online survey entitled *End of Course Reflection*. The Office of Assessment requested survey responses from all full-time, part-time, adjunct, and staff/adjunct instructors. The survey opened on November 28, 2016 and closed on January 24, 2017.

Faculty instructions were sent via email, with periodic reminders.

Directions for the Survey: Please choose ONE course taught this semester that you will teach again. Answer all questions to the best of your ability. The responses to this survey will be used as evidence of course assessment, and will guide future faculty development. The questions related to Mercy Core Values integration, will be shared with the Mission Unit. Shared data will be aggregate with no individual identifiers.


Valid responses totaled 222, including 6 partial completions. With several multiple responses, the total number of faculty responding to the survey was 219. This represented 96% of full-time faculty and 78% of per course faculty.

When asked to state a learning outcome and student success aligned with the outcome, Student success was noted as follows: 148 responded with a percentage of students meeting the outcome successfully, 4 gave a number of students successful, 14 responded with the average grade for an assignment or course, 10 noted student growth or characteristics indicating success, and 18 stated that all or a majority of students were successful. Fifteen responders replied with a description of the assignment.



Q8: What is your status as an instructor at GCU?



Q6: How often have you taught this course?


