### Measure 2: Satisfaction of Employers and Stakeholder Involvement

Georgian Court University Education Department has conducted focus groups with representatives from local school districts to gauge employee and employer satisfaction. In addition, these focus groups were a way for teachers and administrators to give their opinions on what they view as the most pressing matters for educators today and how these items can help shape the way new teachers are prepared for the field.

On April 7, 2025, a focus group was held via Zoom. 19 teachers and administrators were in attendance and the topics of discussion included:

- Program strengths
  - o Dual certification
  - o Great reputation
  - o Good mix of practitioners vs purely full time professors
- Program weaknesses
  - o Would be helpful to have students engage in a Google certification class
  - o Making sure students are familiar with the acronyms they will run into in the field
  - Putting more emphasis on PDPs and having the students mock up their own during student teaching
- Qualities of successful practitioners
  - Most successful practitioners can take theory and quickly move it to practice
- Technology and AI
  - Can be both a positive and a negative and students need to be aware of each side
  - o Students should receive training on what AI can be helpful with
