# CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL BOOK AWARDS

*Georgian Court University's Catholic High School Book Awards program is dedicated to recognizing those high school juniors who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and leadership in service throughout their school and community.*

*Each year, Georgian Court offers two book awards to eligible juniors in every Catholic high school in the dioceses of Trenton, Camden, and Metuchen. In addition, book award recipients who apply to Georgian Court will have their application fee waived and receive a minimum of \$10,000 in aid.*

## Georgian Court Academic Achievement Book Award

The Georgian Court Academic Achievement Book Award recognizes a member of the junior class who has achieved success in a rigorous course load during his or her junior year, while being a respectful, active member of the school's community.

### Award Criteria

- High achievement in schoolwork
- Rigorous course load
- Active participation in school community events
- Demonstration of the Mercy core values of respect, integrity, justice, compassion, and service

## Georgian Court Service and Leadership Book Award

The Georgian Court Service and Leadership Book Award recognizes a junior who has demonstrated exceptional service, leadership ability, and achievement in his or her coursework.

### Award Criteria

- Exceptional work in community service
- Outstanding leadership at school and in the community
- Demonstration of the Mercy core values of respect, integrity, justice, compassion, and service
- Success in coursework
