

DIRECT STAFFORD LOAN BORROWERS-

First time Stafford Loan borrowers must complete Entrance Counseling and sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN). Your financial aid will not disburse to your student account until you complete the processes. Once you complete the processes, the Financial Aid Office will be notified electronically by the Department of Education. Loans for students who have PREVIOUSLY BORROWED FROM GCU will automatically be processed.

If you **do not want Stafford Loans** you must notify the Financial Aid Office in writing or through e-mail that you are declining your loans.

If we do not receive written notification that you wish to decline the loans we will assume you want to accept the loans.
