
Georgian Court University ASSESSMENT



The most recent undergraduate survey (RNL SSI) showed that GCU's top three areas of importance and satisfaction were the following:

- 1. Tutoring services are readily available
- 2. Academic advising assists me in reaching my academic goals
- 3. I receive ongoing feedback about my progress toward my academic goals

In the above areas, we did better than our peers: private 4year colleges and universities. Your impact upon the academic success of our students is well evident.
