### Survey Says... Student and Faculty Engagement Surveys for AY 2022-2023

During the AY 2022-2023 students took the BCSSE (Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement), NSSE (National Survey of Student Engagement) and faculty took the FSSE (Faculty Survey of Student Engagement). Additional modules of Academic Advising and Inclusiveness and Engagement with Cultural Diversity were added to the FSSE and NSSE.

Full results are expected sometime in summer 2023. Interim reports on the FSSE modules were given to the Provost Council at the May meeting. Survey reports can be found on GCU's [IRIS](#) site.

### GCU Teaching Strengths



Every semester, GCU faculty are asked to reflect on their teaching. They choose one course most likely to teach again and consider what changes may be needed to improve their teaching and student learning. Faculty also align course learning to GCU's Mission and Values integration. Course readings and assignments are most often cited for updating.
