Survey Says... Student and Faculty Surveys for AY 2024-2025

Of the undergraduate students who responded to the HEDS Student Satisfaction Survey in Spring 2025, 86% indicated overall satisfaction with their collegiate experience at GCU. For graduate students who responded to the GCU survey, 84% stated that overall they were satisfied with their experience. Results of both surveys are available on IRIS (iris.georgian.edu).



GCU Teaching Strengths

Every semester, GCU faculty are asked to reflect on their teaching. They choose one course most likely to teach again and consider what changes may be needed to improve their teaching and student learning. Student Feedback on Courses



GCU students give course feedback using HelioCampus Assessment and Credentialing (HCAC) System and the GCU Student Evaluation of Teaching (SET) survey. Even with a low response rate of 22.4% for Spring 2025, the overall mean increased again for the 4th straight semester. More detailed reports are available by contacting the OIAA. Note that the Nursing Program was not included in the Spring 2025 results, as they used surveys adapted for clinical and instructional feedback that meets their accreditation standards.
