Two letters of recommendation

Prefer at least one letter of recommendation from a science instructor

College students must submit letters of recommendation from current instructors

Evidence of involvement with school, community and/or extracurricular activities

IELTS/TOEFL scores (if applicable)

Conditions of Admission to SGU School of Medicine

Students must complete the following requirements for full acceptance into SGU School of Medicine by the conclusion of the pathway program:

College transcripts (most recent)

Cumulative GPA of 3.4

Science GPA of 3.2

Successful academic progression

Maximum of 4 years to complete the undergraduate part of the pathway with no more than three repeat courses.

MCAT Score

Obtain a competitive score on the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) within 5 points of the average score for entering students, which is 498. The MCAT is recommended, but not required for international students.

Dean's Letter attesting to student's character and preparation for medical school

Completed SGU Supplemental Application

IELTS/TOEFL scores (if applicable)
