#### LEGISLATIVE PETITION

# \*PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING IN ORDER TO MAKE THE PETITIONING PROCESS AS SIMPLE AS POSSIBLE.

### **Student Government Association Member Requirements**

- 1. All students wishing to petition themselves into the SGA must have and maintain a minimum of 2.5 cumulative grade point average (excluding first-time freshmen).
- 2. All student wishing to petition themselves into the SGA Executive Board must have and maintain a minimum of 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
- 3. SGA meetings are held every Tuesday from 2:00 PM-4:00 PM in the Casino Ballroom.
- 4. Members are expected to attend all SGA events and meetings, and are allotted three unexcused event absences per year and three unexcused meeting absences per semester.
- 5. Senators are required to attend inductions and the fall and spring SGA retreat.
- 6. Senators must serve on assigned SGA standing committee

#### **Election Process**

- 1. The petition process will last at least one week prior to the election.
- 2. Those wishing to run for a seat on the Senate are required to receive a total of 40 full-time Georgian Court student signatures on their petition.
- 3. Those wishing to run for a seat as a Representative are required to receive a total of 40 full-time Georgian Court student signatures on their petition.
  - A. Of the 40 signatures, 20 must be from students who fall into the category in which the representative is running for.
    - i. Example: The commuter representative has to receive 20 of the 40 signatures from commuter students.
  - B. There will be an exception to the number of signatures a representative has to receive when the number of their distinct population is less than 20 students.
  - C. The representative for Mercy mission will need approval from the director of campus ministry.
  - D. Academic representatives must receive 20 of the 40 signatures from full-time students enrolled in that specific school and will need approval from the dean of that specific school.
- 4. Those wishing to run for president of the SGA are required to receive a total of 80 full-time Georgian Court student signatures on their petition. One should only run if they can fulfill the requirements outlined in the Constitution and bylaws.
  - A. All candidates running for president must meet with the moderator prior to officially running for office.
- 5. Those wishing to run for an Executive Board position, other than president, on the Student Government Association are required to receive a total of 60 full-time Georgian Court student signatures on their petition.
- 6. Completed petitions must be handed to and approved by the SGA moderator. Once approved, the candidate will be placed on the ballot and can begin their campaign.
- 7. All candidates must actively campaign for a minimum of one week and follow the campaign policy.
- 8. All candidates will be required to give a speech in public during the designated time in support of their candidacy.
